At the beginning of September after several months of prayer by the Lord's people, the administration at the Almaty teen men's prison granted us permission to once again enter and regularly minister there. It almost came as a surprise, since we had previously been told that there would be no opportunity to serve the inmates there until next year and that was only a possibility, not a guarantee. So praise the Lord with us as He has brought us back through the once-closed gates to share the life-changing message of the gospel. Currently we have the privilege of ministering three days a week teaching the Bible, presenting gospel films and providing English classes for those interested. During the first month and a half we offered guitar lessons but our brother who did the guitar
